Deir al-Paramus is the most secluded monastery in Wadi El Natrun because it is the oldest surviving structure throughout this site. Its name, "Monastery of the Romans," comes from historical roots, and experts estimate the foundation took place in the 4th century. This site bears witness to the prolonged cultural contributions of Coptic Christianity.

You will journey from the peaceful historical site of Wadi El Natrun directly to your waiting Alexandria hotel accommodation.

Then, you will visit the oldest enclosed Deir al-Baramus (Monastery of Baramus) among the four active monasteries. Visitors will find this important historical site attractive because of its peaceful setting that allows full appreciation of monastic origins.
