In the heart of Aswan, where civilization meets the Nile, we set out to explore a unique part of Egypt's history at the Nubian Museum and the Temple of Kalabsha. One day full of magic and heritage awaits you on our day tour with Cairo Top Tours.

You will have the opportunity to explore the Nubian Museum, opened in 1997, which contains 5,000 objects representing the development of Egyptian civilization and the Nubian heritage. The museum's open-air gallery features 68 unique pieces of large archaeological statues and paintings of various sizes, including the most beautiful and rarest, a 200,000-year-old human skeleton found in 1982 in the Edkubat area of Aswan. Among the most important objects in the museum are the statue of King Ramses II, the palace of Abrim, a model of the temple of Philae, a stone painting of Amenhotep, a baboon, and a scorpion.

Additionally, you can go to the Temple of Kalabsha, which is dedicated to the Nubian sun god Mandolis. It was constructed, but not finished, during the reign of Emperor Augustus on the remains of another temple dedicated to King Amenhotep III. The temple is 76 meters long and 22 meters wide.

The temple's walls are covered in numerous historical documents, including the Roman commander Aurelius Bessarion's 250 AD decree that forbade pigs from entering the temple and the writings of Silko, a Christian Nubian king of the kingdom of Nubatia, who describes himself as a Roman soldier on horseback and recounts his conquests of Belmis.

Nubian Museum

The UNESCO-established Nubia Museum in Aswan, Egypt, features artifacts from the ancient Nubian civilization along with information on the history of Nubia from prehistoric times to the present, including a review of the most significant Nubian customs and traditions and the ancient Nubian language.

There are 5,000 objects in the museum that depict the phases of Egyptian civilization and Nubian cultural development. Additionally, there are 68 unique huge statues and paintings of varying sizes on show outside the museum. A human skeleton that is 200,000 years old and was discovered in 1982 in the Edcubateh region of Aswan is among the most exquisite and unique items on exhibit.

The next step is Kalabsha Temple, the second largest temple in the Nubian ruins (after Abu Simbel). The temple, which is 76 meters long and 22 meters wide, was constructed during the reign of Emperor Augustus but was never finished. It is dedicated to the worship of Mandolis, the Nubian sun god, and was constructed on the remains of another temple of King Amenhotep III. Despite being constructed during the Roman era, the temple features drawings of the god Horus on its inner wall.

We will go on an incredible historical adventure amid the captivating Southern ambiance, surrounded by amazing carvings and breathtaking surroundings.

Finally, we will transfer you back to your hotel in Aswan.
