The first Dahshur pyramid was constructed during the reign of King Sneferu, and then Sneferu commissioned the second Dahshur pyramid, the Red Pyramid, which is 104 meters in height and has an inclination of 43 degrees. This pyramid is also called the "Red Pyramid" as red limestone was employed in building it, and is believed to be the tomb of King Sneferu. There are also several royal tombs of royal princesses which have been found in Dahshur, and are laden with luxurious jewelry and precious stones. There are also several smaller pyramids of princesses to the south of Dahshur. Close to the pyramids of Dahshur are several big tombs of Middle and ancient Kingdoms of Egypt officials.

Dahshur is also home to a number of royal princesses' tombs, which are adorned with priceless jewels and expensive jewelry. South of Dahshur, there are a number of smaller princess pyramids. Near the pyramids of Dahshur are a number of large tombs belonging to officials from the ancient and Middle Kingdoms of Egypt.
