Through this opportunity, you will be able to see the Pyramids of Giza. According to one hypothesis, the pyramids are royal tombs, each bearing the name of the king who built it and was buried in it. The construction of pyramids is considered a stage in the evolution of tomb architecture in ancient Egypt, beginning with a small subway pit that later became a chamber and then several rooms topped by a mastaba.

The Pyramids of Giza complex consists of the Great Pyramid, also known as the Pyramid of Cheops, built around 2580-2560 BC, the smaller Pyramid of Khafre, located a few hundred meters to the southwest, and the relatively modest-sized Pyramid of Menkaure, also located a few hundred meters to the southwest. The Great Sphinx is located on the eastern side of the complex, and it is unanimously believed among Egyptologists that the head of the Sphinx represents the head of King Khafre.

Surrounding the Great Pyramid was a tomb with smaller pyramids dedicated to his wives and his mother, Queen Hetep Haras, as well as terraced tombs for members of the royal family and high officials. The original height of the Great Pyramid was 146 meters, but today it is about 137 meters, while its base rib measures 230 meters. The weight of the stones used in the construction ranges from one to eight tons or more.

After that, we started another adventure to one of the most important museums in Egypt, the Egyptian Museum in Tahrir, The museum building is characterized by a neoclassical design and consists of two floors housing distinguished collections of Egyptian antiquities from the Predynastic period to the Greek and Roman eras, including the painting of King Naarmer, commemorating the unification of Upper and Lower Egypt under one king, a collection of statues and artifacts of the pyramid builders, the funerary collection of King Akhenaten's grandfather, Toya, and the treasures of Tanis, plus a large collection of animal mummies, papyri, sarcophagi and jewelry the funerary collection of Akhenaten's grandfather, Yuya and Toya, and the treasures of Tanis, plus a large collection of animal mummies, papyri, coffins and jewelry from various Egyptian eras, and other artifacts that complement the museum's distinctive collection of artifacts.
