Get ready now for one of the best trips you can make during your visit to Egypt, as Cairo Top Tours offers you a unique trip to the Giza plateau, where you will be dazzled by the grandeur of the three imposing pyramids, which are a testimony to the greatness of the ancient Egyptian civilization, because the Great Pyramid, one of the seven wonders of the ancient world is the Pyramid of Cheops. . It was approximately 146.5 meters high when it was built. Next, we headed to the Pyramid of Khafre, characterized by the remains of the limestone shell at its top, and finally to the Pyramid of Menkaure, the smallest of the three. We also enjoyed seeing the Sphinx, which combines the body of a lion with the head of a man and is believed to represent King Khafre. We strolled through the pyramids, took souvenir photos, and enjoyed camel rides in an enchanting historical setting.

We will then proceed to the Citadel neighborhood to see the Sultan Hassan Mosque and Madrasa, one of Cairo's most notable examples of Islamic architecture. Built under the orders of Sultan Hassan ibn al-Nasser Muhammad ibn Qalawun in the fourteenth century AD, it features four iwans devoted to teaching the four schools of Islamic thought. The mosque has a unique design. We can explore its expansive hallways while there and take in the stunning Islamic ornamentation, stained glass windows, and stuccoes that showcase the magnificence of Mamluk architecture during the Mamluk era.

We will also enjoy a visit to the Rifai Mosque, located next to the Sultan Hassan Mosque in Citadel Square. In order to match the splendor of its Mamluk neighbor, Khedive Ismail's mother, Khushiyyar Hanim, built the mosque in the 19th century. The mosque is characterized by its distinctive architectural design, featuring towering columns and elaborate decorations on the exterior walls. The mosque is home to several members of the royal family, including King Fouad I and King Farouk, giving it a distinctive historical character. Wandering through its quiet corridors and contemplating its architectural details made the visit an unforgettable spiritual and cultural experience.

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After your arrival at Cairo airport you will meet one of the expert representatives who will take you in a private air-conditioned car to immerse yourself in the civilization of Cairo.

Our guide will meet you at the beginning and take you on a tour to the Rifai Mosque, which is located next to the Sultan Hassan Mosque on Citadel Square. Khushiya Hanim, Khedive Ismail's mother, built the mosque in the 19th century to match the Mamluk neighbor's splendor. The mosque is distinguished by its distinctive architectural design, which features tall columns and elaborate ornamentation on the outer walls. The mosque has a distinct historical flavor because of the royal family members who have called it home, including King Farouk and King Fouad I. The trip was a fascinating cultural and spiritual experience as we explored its calm corridors and considered its architectural elements.

Our next stop on the tour will be the Sultan Hassan Mosque and Madrasa, one of Cairo's most prominent specimens of Islamic architecture. In the fourteenth century AD, Sultan Hassan ibn al-Nasser Muhammad ibn Qalawun ordered its construction, and it has four iwans that represent the four schools of Islamic thinking... The mosque's architecture is distinctive. The magnificent Islamic embellishments, stained glass windows, and stuccoes that highlight the splendor of Mamluk architecture during the Mamluk era can be seen while exploring its spacious hallways.

Our journey will culminate with a visit to the Great Pyramid, also known as the Pyramid of Cheops, one of the seven wonders of the ancient world. The splendor of ancient Egyptian society is demonstrated by the three massive pyramids. When it was constructed, its height was roughly 146.5 meters. We then proceeded to the smallest of the three, the Pyramid of Menkaure, and then to the Pyramid of Khafre, which is identified by the remains of the limestone shell at its peak. We also liked to view the Sphinx, which is thought to be a representation of King Khafre and combines the head of a man with the body of a lion..

We also enjoy seeing the Sphinx, which is said to represent King Khafre and incorporates a lion's body and a man's head. We will explore the pyramids against an intriguing historical setting, snap pictures as mementos, and ride camels (optional).

Finally, we will transfer you back to Cairo International Airport to catch your flight to Luxor.
