Following Karnak, tourists see the Luxor Temple on the Nile Corniche, which was constructed during the reign of King Amenhotep III to worship the god Amun Ra, in addition to confirming its lineage to the god Amun, in "1390-2353 BC". 2353 BC. AD"
