Arriving at the Giza Plateau, your eyes will feast on the Great Pyramid of Khufu (Cheops), the Pyramid of Khafre (Chephren), and the Pyramid of Menkaure. These impressive structures date as far back as 4500 years, and they still marvel at visitors by magnificently crafted ways and their pertinence in history. As you roam this place, your guide will tell some unexplained mysteries and legends surrounding those pyramids-from construction techniques to glorious myths of secret chambers.

Any complete experience of the Pyramids of Giza would entail riding a camel. Then mount, and you will be taken along with him across golden sands with beautiful panoramic views of the pyramids. Within this environment, much like ancient travelers did, your traveling through the desert is perceived as part of the journey. Live moments will be relived with photos taken here against the pyramids, and you'll experience again the immortal beauty of Egypt's landscapes.

Proceed then to the Great Sphinx, the enigmatic limestone statue with a lion's body and a pharaoh's head. Your guide will tell you all about the history and importance of this huge monument, preserved from centuries as the guardian of the pyramids. Visit the Valley Temple, an ancient site of mummification and religious rituals.

A final lunch at a local restaurant (there is an option without certain guests) and also a chance to explore a bazaar for souvenirs nearby before returning to Sokhna Port. With this excursion, you can experience the magic of ancient Egypt in just one day creating memories for a lifetime.

Early Morning- Collection from Sokhna Port: The tour will start with a comfortable air-conditioned transfer from Sokhna Port while heading towards Cairo through the beautiful countryside of Egypt. The professional tour guide accompanying you will be sharing Egypt's history and broader culture as you make your way. Stunning landscapes, rural villages, and of course, the Nile River, will all be visible, thus giving one a taste of how average Egyptians live their everyday lives. The guide would also talk and share some interesting stories of ancient Egypt, from the building of pyramids to the legends of pharaohs.

Arrival in Giza & Visit to the PyramidsOn arrival in Giza, you will visit this one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World-the Great Pyramids located in Giza. Be amazed by the vastness of the Pyramid of Khufu (Cheops), the Pyramid of Khafre (Chephren), and lastly the Pyramid of Menkaure. This Lunch has a View: Once the pyramids have been visited, be treated to a scrumptious lunch at a local restaurant which overlooks the pyramids. Take in the aerial views within the desert landscape as you enjoy a meal in-house, letting yourself absorb the wonder of this historical site.

Optional Stopover at a Papyrus Institute or Bazaar. You might visit a papyrus institute for viewing how the

ancient Egyptians used to make paper or alternatively go to a bazaar for shopping souvenirs like handmade crafts, jewelry, and perfumes if time allows. You will witness some very fine artisanal skills used in these traditional Egyptian goods and carry home a piece of history. This is also a very good opportunity to mingle with local artisans and learn more about Egypt's cultural rich heritage.

Return to Sokhna Port. After spending a fabulous day in Giza, take the easy drive back to Sokhna Port, where the cruise departs. Sit back and relax and think over the reflections of the day's sights and experiences with the easily comfortable ride back.
