Then admire the Citadel of Qaitbay, a 15th-century fortress built on the very site of the much-diminished Lighthouse of Alexandria. From here, there are breathtaking views of the Mediterranean using the opportunity to visit the Bibliotheca Alexandrina, a modern wonder of architecture honoring the ancient Library of Alexandria.

A delicious seafood lunch is included at a local restaurant before you take an exhilarating walk along the Corniche while absorbing the city's vibrant culture. The last stop is visiting the gorgeous Montaza Palace Gardens, a calm oasis filled with greenery and royal palaces.

Alexandria Tour

The modern Library of Alexandria was built in honor of the ancient world's most famous library. Admire the unique architecture, large collection of books, and cultural exhibits. Visit the 15th-century fortress, built on the site of the legendary Lighthouse of Alexandria. Walk down the ancient walls while soaking up magnificent views of the Mediterranean Sea.

The palatial gardens of Montaza unfold before you- a sublime royal weekend getaway with marvelous coastlines, sprawling greenery, and breathtaking architecture. Enjoy a stroll or take a quick break by the sea.
