The fighting had claimed the lives of some 13,000 Allied soldiers, while more than 70,000 others were injured.

El Alamein comprises its historical legacy with a very coherent vision for the future, making it essentially destined for history enthusiasts and avid travelers to witness the dynamic transformation of Egypt. Winston Churchill stated that, before El-Alamein, we (the allies he means) never had a victory and after El-Alamein, we never had a defeat. The cemetery contains 7,240 Commonwealth burials of the Second World War. There are 102 war graves of other nationalities. After that, you will head to see the war cemetery known as the Commonwealth cemetery in Egypt which includes the graves of soldiers from many nations killed during the war, and you will continue to the German and Italian tombs and memorials as well.
