You will be welcomed at Cairo International Airport by our charming tour leader, who will collect you in a private vehicle and an air-conditioned car to prepare you for a full day of exploration into the famous landmarks of Egypt. The Giza Plateau will be your first destination, where you will admire the famous Great Pyramids of Giza: Cheops, Khafre, and Menkaure. Stand in the shadows of these ancient wonders and learn about their mysteries with your private guide. Discover the Valley Temple of King Khafre and learn how the body of the pharaoh was prepared for burial, and, finally, pay a visit to the Great Sphinx, the enigmatic guardian of the pyramids.

From here, continue via Dahshur, which houses two of Egypt's most interesting pyramids: the Red Pyramid and the Bent Pyramid, both built during Pharaoh Sneferu's reign. The Red Pyramid, the first true smooth-sided pyramid in the world, stands in sharp contrast to the Bent Pyramid, which is uniquely angled. Here you will also enjoy a memorable donkey ride, affording a unique view of the Egyptian traditional countryside and desert landscape.

Then, after such an exciting day of sightseeing, enjoy a traditional lunch in a tranquil Egyptian village, where you can indulge in truly local culinary delights while experiencing warm Egyptian hospitality. After the comforting views of the countryside, it is back to the Cairo International Airport for your smooth transfer onward or departure.
