Walk back into Memphis and Giza Pyramids Tour, and history unfolds before two of Egypt's most iconic perspectives of ancient offerings. The journey begins in the first capital of ancient unified Egypt-that had been founded about 5,000 years ago. Here-before setting off for the Giza Pyramids-you will walk amidst colossal statues and remnants of temples that were built to honor gods and pharaohs: the magnificent fallen statue of Ramses II and the neat and finely preserved Alabaster Sphinx.

Your guide tells you of the once-vibrant capital and how it entered into Egyptian history during the early dynastic period, which was the beginning of Egypt as a civilized nation.

Then, your tour moves on to the breathtaking Giza Plateau, where stands the only remaining Wonder of the Ancient World: The Great Pyramid of Khufu. These gigantic tombs were erected for the pharaohs Khafre and Menkaure. On the contrary, from the Great Sphinx with its mysterious grimace of a human face on a lion's body, and the legends and historical controversies that surround this symbolic guardian of the plateau.

Itinerary

Giza Pyramids and Memphis City

Your knowledgeable Egyptologist guide will pick you up from your accommodation in Cairo or Giza to begin your day. The first stop is Memphis, the capital city of ancient Egypt during the Old Kingdom. Stroll in the open-air museum with majestic colossal statues of Ramses II and the Alabaster Sphinx as proud emblematic reminders of the city's past glory. Learn how Memphis functioned as a center for culture and religion, and gaze at a collection of artifacts whose origin can be traced back to the heart of this ancient city since the early dynastic era.

Next, proceed towards the nearby Giza Plateau to have an up-close encounter with the world-famous Pyramids of Giza. Feared to be mighty with their architecture, the three great pyramids are Khufu, Khafre, and Menkaure. The Great Sphinx, a representation of ancient Egypt made from a single slab of limestone, stands majestically in front. Your knowledgeable guide will go into further detail about the myths and mysteries surrounding these monuments. After a tour of the monuments, enjoy some free time for photo sessions or an optional camel ride before making your way back to the hotel, which contains plenty of ancient marvels and unforgettable scenes.
