The canal's history describes the birth of intensive construction in the 19th century, thus linking it to international shipping today.

Explore the Suez Canal Authority Building (if open). Sit at a viewpoint on the scenic point to see the waterway's panoramas. Stroll down the banks and witness the uniquely fascinating site where ships appear to float down through the desert. The Suez Canal Museum statement features interactive exhibitions about construction and expansion accompanied by historical relics indicating the canal's importance to the economy of Egypt. Take a little boat ride while on the canal and experience firsthand the engineering wonder if time allows.

Then, after the fascinating visit, have a perfect seafood or Egyptian-style local lunch at a restaurant with views over the canal. Walk along the waterway before commencing the journey back to Cairo while reminiscing about the great combination of history, technology, and the world that is the Suez Canal. This excursion is an extremely rare opportunity for guided smooth transport and phenomenal sights to see one of the world's leading waterways.

Begin with an easy ride from Cairo to the Suez Canal, the most important waterways in the world. Reach Ismailia or Port Said- two vibrant cities that give impressive views of the canal and its constant flow of large cargo ships. Get to know the exciting history of the canal: from its construction in the 19th century until now, when it has been a significant player in global trade. Have a stop at the Building of the Suez Canal Authority or one of the local viewpoints to watch the vessels pass through this strategic waterway from the Mediterranean to the Red Seas.

Experience the culture and history of this area by visiting Port Fouad, a pretty little town reachable by ferry, with charming lanes along which to stroll while having wonderful views of the canal. Depending on the itinerary, you might enjoy a local museum visit or have a look at some military memorials dedicated to the history of the canal in Egypt. Enjoy a quiet midday seafood restaurant where fresh local fare flavors handsomely include a sneak preview inside history with leisure.

Then in the afternoon, take that fabled drive across parts of the canal, stopping at some of the engineering landmarks for photographs. Your expert guide will throw light on how the canal has been operating, the various expansions it has undergone, and its impact on international trade. Before heading back to Cairo, you will also be allowed a bit of free time to visit local markets or relax at the waterfront.
