You can follow cobblestone paths through small streets to reach both El Muallaqa's (The Hanging Church) and Saints Sergius and Bacchus Church which legend says the Holy Family used during their journey in Egypt. The Jewish heritage and folk tales of the Ben Ezra Synagogue lure visitors to its doors.

Next, delve into the splendor of Islamic Cairo, a labyrinth of bustling bazaars, grand mosques, and medieval architecture. Marvel at the majestic Sultan Hassan Mosque, the intricate details of Al-Azhar Mosque, and the striking beauty of the Citadel of Saladin. Take a few minutes to immerse yourself in the lively atmosphere of Khan El Khalili Bazaar which reveals mysterious dimensions between its spice aromas glowing brass lanterns and busy street vendors.

Your visit should end at the Egyptian Museum which showcases thousands of years of historic artifacts that fill its collections. Appreciate pharaonic antiquities in their many forms which showcase King Tut's legendary treasures and elegant statues together with mummies through the collections at this site.

The Egyptian Museum and Old Coptic Cairo Trip

During a day tour of Cairo, the tour takes visitors to the Egyptian Museum so they can observe ancient Egyptian artifacts including King Tutankhamun's valuables and ornaments. Your guide will spend two hours showing you which details exist within these artifacts. The burial place of Tutankhamun contained thousands of years of hidden gold and silver jewelry before its archaeological discovery.

After the Alabaster Mosque of Mohammed Ali at the Salah al-Din Citadel, you will proceed to Islamic Cairo's main attraction. Built by the Ottomans the mosque functioned as the Egyptian government's headquarters from Salah Eldin's reign to the early 1900s.

A selection of Egyptian cuisine awaits visitors for lunch at this point. Visitors on the Coptic Cairo tour get to see the earliest significant Egyptian churches which include Babylon's historic Roman fortress alongside the Hanging Church Church of St. Sergius and the Ben Ezra Synagogue.

The Al-Hakim Mosque stands alongside medieval fortifications as pillars of the greatest Islamic neighborhood within Cairo. Your day tours will end with transportation back to your place of accommodation.
