Tuk Tuk Tour in Cairo Tour

Official City Tuk Tuk Tour offers a different kind of sightseeing experience of the city, with the sights and scenery of Cairo's hidden quiet neighborhoods and lively backstreets. Here, you will be familiarized with the colorful tuk tuk, which will take you amidst narrow alleys, markets bustling with life, and historic districts that bigger vehicles usually cannot access. Along these streets, in far-flung districts, away from the usual tourist crowds, one finds the ordinary daily life of Cairo. With a local guide, you visit authentic neighborhoods, watch traditional craftsmen at work, and visit mosques and cultural sites.

Pause for a quick bite and drink at a street-side cafe, possibly with the company of a few locals while taking in the atmosphere. Meanwhile, your guide narrates riveting tales of Cairo's modern urban culture, born from an interesting melting pot of traditions, and your understanding of the soul of Cairo deepens. A lovely sunset at a scenic rooftop or hidden courtyard concludes the last stretch of your ride, from where you return to your hotel, all in all, with a different outlook on the pulsating life of Cairo.
