The Great Pyramid of King Cheops is the sole survivor among the seven ancient wonders, built by King Chephren during the old kingdom. The pyramid of Mycerinus stands as a major tourist attraction due to its construction using limestone and granite.

After the Great Pyramid, you will continue your exploration through Egypt, visiting the Valley Temple of King Chephren, which served as the site for royal body preparation during mummification ceremonies. This tomb is believed to symbolize the wisdom and intelligence of King Chephren, who was also a semi-god. The famous statue with a human head and lion's body is believed to have been carved for King Chephren to be a guardian of the pyramids and to symbolize his wisdom and intelligence.

You will then continue your half-day tours in Cairo, entering the Valley Temple of King Chephren, where the royal body of the king was embalmed during mummification. The temple is located in front of the Great Sphinx. In the evening, you can enjoy camel riding at the Giza plateau, with expert guidance helping you capture unforgettable moments throughout your Egypt Day Tours.

Itinerary

Saladin Citadel, El Moez Street and Khan El Khalili Bazaar tour

Start your Cairo City Tour by meeting our Cairo Top Tours Egyptologist guide for a tour of Medieval Cairo and Egyptian history, starting with the Citadel of Saladin.

It was built by one of the most famous Egyptian monarchs; his name is Sultan Salah Al-Din in the 12th century to defend Cairo after the Islamic conquest of Egypt against the crusader's campaigns. You will also visit the Alabaster Mosque of Mohamed Ali, which he started building in 1830 by the Turkish architect Yusuf Bushnak; he died before its completion in 1849 during the Ottoman era in Egypt.

Resume your Cairo Tours to go through a lot of Islamic Cairo monumental buildings represented in El Moez Street which was established in 969, it is named after the Caliph Al-Muizz, and the effects of the street date back to the Fatimid, Ayyubid, and Mamluk eras, to attest to the splendor of the civilizations that existed at that time. This Islamic Cairo Tour will take you through the historic buildings and mosques that show the greatest variety of medieval architectural wealth anywhere in the Islamic world, as well as the oldest bazaar in Egypt.

Khan El Khalili Bazaar has been in existence for over 600 years and, despite all these years, has been able to maintain the form of monumental buildings dating back to the era of the Mamluks, who were mercenaries brought by Sultan Saladin to be reared in the army. It is considered one of the most important and ancient historical neighborhoods in Cairo, attracting tourists due to its beautiful atmosphere.

Later, you will be transferred back to your Cairo hotel after finishing your Cairo trip.
