Travelers can visit the Monastery of the Virgin Mary on the cliffs of Gabal Al-Teir where they can both enjoy Coptic Christian pilgrimage appreciation and breathtaking views across the Nile Valley.

Itinerary

Day 1: El Minya Tour

Set sail into an incredible travel experience, once again, from Luxor to El-Minya, accompanied by an expert Egyptologist guide. The journey begins early in the morning by hotel to depart by 6:00 AM on a picturesque six-hour journey northward toward 402 km. Get started learning about the ancient history of Tell El-Amarna as you straighten out the past from the time of Pharaoh Akhenaten, who originated in 1346 B.C. The ancient city became the capital city of the founders' radical monotheistic worship of Aten, the sun god. Visit the remaining artifacts from this now-deserted city, where Akhenaten along with Queen Nefertiti began a new vision, artistically and religiously, of Egypt in their time.

Following this immersive experience at Tell El-Amarna, enjoy a sumptuous oriental meal at a carefully selected local restaurant that will bring you to the true taste of Egyptian flavors. After the meal, continue the journey admiring the historical touch of El-Minya, with its beautiful Nile-side scenic views, and tell the fascinating stories revolving around ancient Egyptian history.

As night falls, transfer to a comfortably arranged hotel in El-Minya for an overnight stay. Use the evening to unwind while exploring your local surroundings or simply reflecting on all the incredible things you've experienced during the day before continuing your journey the next day.

Day 2: Beni Hassan and the Northern Tombs

After breakfasting well at your hotel in El-Minya, the Egyptologist appointed with you will meet and take you to continue the journey through the amazing wonders of history in the land. The present stop on this journey takes us to the Beni Hasan tombs, situated about 20 km south of El-Minya. These are amazing burial sites dating back to the Middle Kingdom and were used as the last resting places of provincial rulers and high officials of the time. The tomb walls have vibrant scenes that show daily life in ancient Egypt, complete with detailed illustrations of athletic wrestling techniques, giving observers an extremely rare glimpse into the past.

Begin your tour with the Tomb of Bakhet III, the gubernatorial governor of the Oryx Nome around the 11th Dynasty, and then move to the Tomb of Khnumhotep, a major official who served under Pharaoh Amenemhat. Go to the Tomb of Khety, which is also a fascinating point for dissecting carvings and murals. Explore the Northern Tombs before wrapping up your visit; they will bring an additional perspective into the lives of ancient Egyptian elites and their burial tradition.

After a fun trip, you might have a well-prepared lunch in a local restaurant, where you can laze back and brood over where you have been. Now start going back to Luxor while looking at the wonderful hill and Nile scenery while rounding up this unforgettable tour.
