Blue hole and colored canyon in Sharm El Sheikh

The first stop is at the Colored Canyon, a complete natural wonder that, for thousands of years, has been carved by wind and water. Admire the narrow sandstone walls of an almost unimaginably wide canyon colored red, orange, and yellow-God's palettes while your guide tells you interesting facts about the geology and the uniqueness of this desert formation. Given the mesmerizing patterns that will challenge all your photography skills, make the most of these photo opportunities.

After the canyon and a light snack, the tour proceeds to the world-famous Blue Hole, a renowned diving and snorkeling site next to Dahab. This underwater sinkhole is characterized by crystal-clear waters and lively marine life, making it a paradise for snorkelers and divers. Infuse an unforgettable hour of swimming amid colorful coral reefs, tropical fishes, and maybe even sea turtles. Those seeking relaxation can cuddle up on the shores, soaking in the allure of the Red Sea. Following this, you will head toward a seaside restaurant in Dahab to feast on a delicious lunch consisting of fresh seafood and traditional Egyptian cuisine.
