Saggara - Where Pyramid Construction Was Born

At Saqqara, you will walk into one of the most important archaeological areas of Egypt. It is home to the world's first-ever pyramid, the Step Pyramid of Djoser, which is an important architectural innovation designed by Imhotep, the architect of Pharaoh Djoser.

During your trip, you will:

Visit the vast necropolis, where pharaohs and high officials were interred.

Explore the pyramid of Unas, famous for its Pyramid Texts-the oldest religious texts in history.

See the Mastaba tombs, where colorful hieroglyphs and carvings depict scenes of everyday life, ritual, and ancient Egyptians' beliefs.

The Red Pyramid: The world's first true pyramid, also built by Sneferu, and the direct predecessor to the Great Pyramid of Giza. You can enter this pyramid and stroll down narrow corridors within the original structure.

If time permits, a quick stop at an Egyptian handicraft store will give you a chance to browse for authentic souvenirs ranging from handmade papyrus, alabaster statues, and cartouche jewelry.
