The architectural styles and elements of the museum were influenced by Greek classical art and architecture.

Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival and check-in

A member of our staff will be waiting for you in the airport's arrivals hall after you have finished your airport formalities. You will then be driven in an air-conditioned private car. Day 2: Visit the most important sites

Your experienced tour guide will meet you in the lobby of your hotel at the agreed time after your delicious breakfast to start your Egypt tour. Firstly, you will visit the three pyramids, firstly you will see the Pyramid of Cheops, the Great Pyramid.

And you will see the pyramid of Khafre, Khafre ruled Egypt between 2558 and 2532 B.C. He built the second pyramid of the Giza pyramids, and it is worth mentioning that he was married to four wives, including Kha-Marr Nabti and Mars Ankh III. You will see the Wadi Khafre temple, a temple built of granite stones next to the pyramid, where a bridge connects it to the pyramid, and there are several statues of King Khafre and the god Horus, known as the falcon god because he takes the shape of a falcon.

After lunch at a local restaurant serving Egyptian cuisine, we will take a tour of the Egyptian Museum. You will visit the Egyptian Museum, which marks 122 years since the opening of the Egyptian Museum in Tahrir, which was officially opened on 15 November 1902 and is considered the oldest and first national museum in the Middle East, the fifth building that houses Egyptian antiquities, and its long history is still illuminated today

The museum was designed by Hakian Effendi and directed by Yusuf Dia Effendi. At the same time, Sheikh Rifa'a al-Tahtawi, in charge of excavating and preserving Egyptian antiquities, ordered that no further excavations be carried out without his permission, and announced that he was strictly forbidden to leave Egypt and that all discoveries would be transferred to the Azbakeya Museum.

Then you will be transferred to Salah Al-Din Citadel and see the many Islamic monuments that have been added to it over the ages, including Mohammed Ali Pasha Mosque, Al-Nasser Mohammed bin Qalawun

Mosque, Suleiman Pasha Al-Khadem Mosque, and Youssef's Well, in addition to a number of museums such as the police, Al-Jawhara Palace, and Al-Harbi.

Finally, you will be transferred to the airport or any preffered place in Cairo.
