Barqash Market was first established in the Baragil area of the famous Imbaba district, and continued there until the beginning of 1995, before moving to its current location, where buying and selling operations take place every day of the week, although Friday and Sunday remain the peak days of each week, when the selling system changes from “practice” to “auction”, after the market witnessed in recent years

The Bargash market handles approximately 150,000 camels annually, with an average of 12,000 per month. These animals undergo veterinary inspection before arriving from various countries via southern Egypt, particularly since most of them come from Sudan, a meeting point for camels from various countries. The market re-markets these animals to various governorates.

The Barqash Market in Giza is one of the most well-known camel marketplaces in Egypt. It serves as a gathering spot for camel enthusiasts from different Arab and African nations who want to sell camels to other enthusiasts. The market occupies twenty-five acres. Our guide will teach you more because it's a unique trip around Egypt.
