The Egyptian Museum, the most popular and the oldest Egyptian museum. Subsequently you will be transferred to Salah al-Din Citadel. One of the most significant sites of Islamic Cairo, it is also one of the oldest military castles. Its location on a rocky hill adjacent to the Mokattam Mountain offers a strategic view of all the famous historical sights in Cairo.

Moreover, you will get the chance to see the Mohamed Ali Mosque, also known as the Alabaster Mosque, which is an Ottoman-style Mosque. Then you'll head towards an oriental restaurant to taste some Egyptian food. And then move to Coptic Cairo to visit some of the most famous churches like the ancient Church of St. Sergius which was built by Saints Sergius and Bacchus, who are known as the Church of Abi Serga, over an old Roman fortress.

The Houses of Ibn Ezra is a temple of enormous significance in the Egyptian Jewish tradition found somewhere in Old Cairo, Egypt. It has grown popular ever since the government started care of this temple, and brought restorations to the standards, making it listed as a monument and tourist attraction.
