Giza Pyramids, Memphis, and Sakkara

Explore the pyramids, which were built on the heights to avoid the Nile River from flooding and near it to facilitate the transportation of limestone, and a solid rocky area of the desert plateau was chosen for construction to provide support and protect it from collapsing or cracking.

Enjoy seeing the Sphinx as well and explore the Sphinx that was once surrounded by a temple: Archaeological excavations have revealed a small temple located in front of the Sphinx, believed to have been used for religious rituals and ceremonies.

Also visit the Valley Temple of King Khafre, The valley temple was built with huge limestone stones its walls were covered with blocks of polished pinkish-red granite, and the floor of the temple was made of alabaster stones. The lobby is currently open to the sky, but it was roofed with granite blocks centered on 16 columns and there were twenty-three statues of King Khafre that we can still see the places of their bases on the floor of the temple.

Additionally, you will get the opportunity to see Egypt's first pyramid: The earliest pyramid construction endeavor in ancient Egypt was Djoser's Step Pyramid. It started out as a straightforward mastaba and developed into a six-story stepped pyramid over time. Imhotep, a brilliant engineer who was eventually deified many years after his death, constructed the pyramid.

Finally, Memphis was founded by King Mina: According to legend, Memphis was founded by King Mina, who united the two Egyptian continents. The city became an important political and religious center in ancient Egypt. Don't miss our personalized offers

Full-Day Tour to Giza Pyramids, Memphis, and Sakkara

Our representative will meet you in front of your hotel to come to visit the pyramids. First, you will see the Great Pyramid, which was built by Prince Ham Ionu, King Khufu's architect - a larger-than-life-size limestone statue of him is preserved in the Römer-Belisius Museum in Hildesheim, Germany. He sent priests and engineers to the city of Un to choose a name for the pyramid, and that name was: 'Akhet Khufu', which means "the horizon of Khufu". It represents the horizon from which the god Ra will board the sun boats to sail and the stars will row for him.

You will also learn about the pyramid of King Khafre the design of this pyramid differed greatly from other Egyptian pyramids, as most pyramids had hidden entrances that were not visible to the viewer, but this pyramid, had two entrances from the northern side of the pyramid, both visible to the viewer and leading to the burial chamber, the height of the entrance was about 11 meters from ground level, the entrance leads to a descending corridor with a granite roof, and its slope angle is about 22 degrees.

After providing your guide with information about the Pyramid of Menkaure, we will learn about Egyptian culture by eating an Egyptian dish. You will be transferred to Saqqara necropolis, which includes about 13 pyramids, in which kings from the ancient era were buried, and citizens and senior officials were also buried there, starting from the ancient history of Egypt, whether (Pharaonic, Greek, and Roman), it also has several monasteries and the largest animal necropolis, and it is expected with the continuation of work in it to find human and animal tombs in all its parts in any period.

Enjoy a visit to Memphis that was enjoyed under the Hellenistic Ptolemaic dynasty Memphis retained its cosmopolitan character, and at the beginning of the Roman era (1st century BC), Memphis was a regional capital celebrating its regional machinery, until the serious decay of the ancient city began after the advent of Christianity when fanatics defaced and destroyed the remaining pagan temples, and the decline of the capital continued, until it received the fatal blow during the Islamic conquest of Egypt in 640 AD. At the end of our amazing tour, you will be transferred to your hotel to rest.
