Day 1 - Arrival in Fayoum

Outside your hotel, your driver will be waiting for you. After giving you a warm greeting, he will take you to Fayoum so you may start your tour by seeing the Kom Oshim Museum. The museum features ancient statues that reveal the scent of ancient Egyptian civilization and the greatness of our ancestors' history, as well as distinctive artworks dating back thousands of years, telling different stories and legends... Your guide will provide you with information about the history of this museum.

We move on to the city of Karanis, the ruins of a complete ancient city, with a royal street in the middle. It includes a self-contained neighborhood containing a bakery, a mill, and a grain storehouse, in addition to two baths from the Roman era, two temples, one in the north and the other in the south, a cemetery, as well as grape presses and grain mills. This scene makes you feel like you've ridden in a time machine back to the Greco-Roman era, where the ancient city of Karanis is located in Fayoum Governorate...

Enjoy exploring the Hawara Pyramid, built of mud bricks covered with limestone. The original height of the pyramid was 58 meters, with each side measuring 105 meters long. The pyramid contains numerous corridors and chambers, ending with the burial chamber. A huge stone sarcophagus made of a single piece of quartzite weighing 110 tons was found inside.

Once a recreational beach for kings, leaders and dignitaries, where King Farouk used to spend most of his time inside the lake in the Lisan area, practicing duck hunting, since 1989 you too can relax on the lake's shores after it was declared a nature reserve. Enjoy the beach of this lake.

Enjoy the waterfalls of Wadi Al-Rayan and then move to the village of Tunis, characterized by its location on a high plateau on the banks of Lake Qarun, and it is spread with green spaces and covered with trees and flowers in their distinct and multiple colors, while behind it lies the vast desert. Enjoy a night of meditation by camping in Fayoum under the stars.

Day 2 - Fayoum-Cairo

In the morning, prepare to be transported to Wadi al-Hitan (The Valley of the Whales), a journey that will take you back to distant geological eras, immersing you in your imagination of ancient life. Here, in Wadi al-Hitan, on land that emerged from the depths of the sea, in the Western Desert of Egypt, fossilized landscapes paint a mental picture of what life was like 40 million years ago.

Here, death is evidence of a life that existed 40 million years ago, in a desert that embraces the remains of land whale skeletons, with diverse landscapes formed by nature in the Fayoum Desert, roots emerging from the branches of mangrove trees, that have endured for tens of millions of years, rocks carved by grains of sand carried by the wind, across different and changing geological eras.

We'll enjoy lunch before heading to Madinat Madi, the ancient city of Madi, which was discovered by chance by the Italian archaeologist and papyrologist, Achille Fogliano, head of the Milanese expedition, in 1937, is located 35 kilometers west of the city of Fayoum, near the village of Atsa. Curiously, the inscriptions found by Fogliano confirmed two different reigns. The inscriptions on the western side bore the name of King Amenemhat III, while the eastern side bore the name of King Amenemhat IV. The left-hand chapel was decorated with scenes of offerings to the god Sobek, and on the opposite side, the king presents a perfume vessel to the goddess Rennut in the form of a cobra. Finally, we will return to your hotel in Cairo.
