The second room contains pottery vessels, King Tutankhamun's weapons, and his chess set. The third part of the tomb contains four compartments and is known to be the burial chamber, where numerous bodies were found and a solid gold coffin.

The village includes the royal coronation procession, artistic and entertainment shows, marionette performances, children's competitions, and folklore and tanoura dance performances, all designed to meet the needs of tourists and visitors of all tastes, from 12:00 PM to 4:00 PM.

The Pharaonic Village highlights a replica of the underground tomb of Tutankhamun, along with a variety of museums that embody different civilizations throughout the ages, starting with the Pyramid Builders Museum, Mummification, the Royal Family of the Muhammad Ali Dynasty, the Inventions Museum, Cleopatra of Nubia, Heritage, Gamal Abdel Nasser, Anwar Sadat, and Modern Egypt.

Enjoy the sound effects and the movement of the Pharaonic-style boats, a path that takes you back thousands of years, starting with the legend of Osiris and Isis, and the traditional struggle between good and evil, passing through the great kings of Egypt, and the battles they led in defense of the country's borders and the extension of its civilization, then a live show that simulates the reality of all the activities, crafts and industries practiced by the ancient Egyptians, starting with agriculture, in which the ancient Egyptian farmer excelled, and for which he invented tools and methods that the farmer of the twenty-first century still uses to this day, so that these methods enjoy a special luster and a distinctive form to this day.
