People are forced by circumstances to travel short distances, sometimes a very limited number of kilometers. Using an expensive taxi would be an economic burden. Hence, the idea of providing a cheap means of transportation for such short distances was born, and the tuk-tuk was used for such distances. The tuk-tuk, with its single axle, three wheels, and two-cylinder engine, is the more affordable automobile. In the 1950s, it became more popular in developing nations, especially in Africa, India, and Thailand.
