This pyramid is located on the southern side of the Saqqara pyramid and was built to be the tomb of King Onas, who belonged to the fifth dynasty of the Pharaonic monarchy, its chambers were inscribed with hieroglyphic inscriptions known as the Pyramid Texts, and these inscriptions are considered the first religious document in the world.
