You're going to the Great Pyramid. Khufu emerged as the earthly ruler of Horus, necessitating the construction of his own tomb—the first national undertaking in ancient Egypt. Professional workers from all over Egypt participated in its construction, and the Great Pyramid remained at its original height of "148 meters" for about 3800 years, and it is the largest building built by man.
