The city of Saqqara is full of archaeological information. You will be able to visit the ruins of the Third Dynasty. We will explore the most famous pyramid in the region, the Pyramid of Sisyphus. The pyramid began as a mastaba tomb, a flat structure with sloping sides, and through a series of expansions evolved into a 197-foot (60-meter) high pyramid, with six tiers, each built on top of another.

Then you will move on to the Pyramid of Onas, the smallest of the pyramids of the Old Kingdom, but it holds significance as it contains the pyramid texts. You will be allowed to enter the Pyramid of Unas.

The last pyramid built for a queen in ancient Egypt, the Teti Chery pyramid is characterized by a distinctive construction method compared to mud-brick pyramids.

Its construction is credited to the great architect Imhotep, and through our tours, you will be able to explore the Imhotep Museum, whose most important holdings include mummified cottage cheese and the oldest royal mummy in mummification, from his era.

Saqqara contains some of the historical pyramids and the most famous ones, such as King Teti's pyramid, the pyramid of Unas, and the smallest one too. You will also get the chance to visit these noble tombs which are peculiar in nature and contain the remains of many prominent leaders from the 18th to the 20th dynasties.
