The Egyptian Museum in Tahrir, located in the heart of Cairo, houses the largest collection of ancient Egyptian antiquities, as it contains more than 150,000 pharaonic artifacts, of which 50,000 pieces are displayed to the public, and the story of the establishment of the museum began in 1863, when Khedive Ismail approved the project to establish a museum of Egyptian antiquities.

You will be transferred to Luxor Airport, which is distinguished by a pharaonic design different from the rest of Egypt's airports upon your arrival at Cairo Airport and our guide will receive you in a modern air-conditioned private car to take you to the most important and largest archaeological site, which is the Pyramids of Giza, which are the tombs of the ancient pharaohs, their kings and their king Pharaohs were mummified and buried inside the pyramids with many treasures to enjoy a good life in the afterlife. The pyramids were also built to keep thieves away from the gold and offerings that the pharaohs were buried in. They are built of stone and have buried chambers.
