Named after St. Catherine, who was killed in the fourth century AD and whose bones monks believe are in one of the churches, St. Catherine's Monastery was built in the sixth century AD as a safe haven for monks by decree of Byzantine Emperor Justinian I.

The monastery maintains an impenetrable wall and towering towers designed to repel any attack. The walls are between 40 and 200 feet high, reflecting the unique architectural character that made the monastery an impenetrable place and a witness to history.

Then you will start your tour of the Coloured Canyon, which is a maze of rocks that reaches a height of between 40 and 80 meters in some places, and is considered one of the natural wonders of Taba Reserve, consisting of colored rocks in the form of cliffs that resemble a dry riverbed, about 800 meters in length, and is known to have been formed by rainwater and winter torrents that dug channels in the middle of the mountains.

The valley is characterized by a group of rocks of various shapes and sizes, each of which has its own nature, making it suitable for climbing, whether for amateurs or professionals, provided there is a specialized escort, and it is necessary for each climber to choose the type of rock that is most suitable for him; there is fairly easy climbing when choosing ordinary rocks.
