3200 BC its capital was Ihnaysa, where King Menes built an earthen dam in front of the Lahun opening above the rocky bottom of Bahr Youssef. The kings of the Third Dynasty obtained stones from Jabal al-Qatrani to use in paving the Great Pyramid Temple in 2600 BC.

At the beginning of the dynastic era, some villages appeared east of the depression, where people settled on the banks of Lake Moiris and worked in agriculture and fishing. When the reclaimed area increased, its name became (Bar Sobek), meaning the house of the crocodile, due to the abundance of crocodiles in the area, which were worshipped in Fayoum under the name of the god "Sobek." Tour to Fayoum from Sharm El Sheikh

After being flown to Cairo, you will be driven to Fayoum. Explore Fayoum's past, which includes relics from the era of the Pharaohs.

After that, we went to the region, which was entirely beneath the water. Winds created the photos, and the location perfectly combines the reserve's natural history with local culture. He pointed out that the area was filled with life and extinct animals like sharks and whales 40 million years ago. A desert habitat with sand dunes, natural springs, flora, fauna, and marine fossils is what sets the Wadi El Rayan Protected Area apart. The reason for naming Wadi El Rayan Reserve is due to a king called Rayyan bin Al Walid who lived in this area with his army and used to draw water from the natural springs available in the area.
