There are huge temples built in memory of the most famous pharaohs of their time, such as the Ramsesium Temple, which bears the name of Ramses II with its columns and inscriptions that tell stories about his exploits, especially the Battle of Kadesh and his victory over the Hittites around 1274 BC.

You will be picked up from your hotel in Sharm El Sheikh and transferred to Sharm El Sheikh International Airport. Upon arrival at Luxor International Airport, which is characterized by the character of Luxor's antiquities and the presence of hieroglyphic inscriptions on the walls of the airport, your tour guide will meet you in a private vehicle where you will visit

Karnak Temple, which the Greeks called the "Temple of Heaven on Earth" because its columns almost touch the edges of the sky.

Then you will continue your tour to Luxor Temple, whose road stretches along a set of rams' statues, connecting Karnak with another temple of the "The City of the Living", the Luxor Temple, located south of the city.

Enjoy a delicious meal of Egyptian delicacies before your transfer to the West Bank, where you'll find another unique open-air museum, the Funerary Museum, both figuratively and literally. The Valley of the Kings and Valley of the Queens are tombs nestled into the rocks.

Facing Karnak, Queen Hatshepsut constructed her beautiful temple in Deir el-Bahri on Luxor's west bank. Jisro Jisro, which translates to "the holy of holies," was the name given to Hatshepsut's temple. Senenmut, an engineer, created it. After participating in our outstanding tour, you will be driven to the Luxor Airport and then to your hotel in Sharm El Sheikh to recuperate.
