Explore the about 5,200 varied objects from various times housed in the Sharm El-Sheikh Museum. The city, which is well-known for its beach and entertainment tourism, seeks to boost cultural tourism. According to Edward, the museum includes three main halls.

The first highlights the wildlife and daily life in ancient Egypt. The second hall (the Royal Corridor) highlights some of Egypt's kings. The third hall (Civilizations) displays artifacts from ancient Egyptian eras, in addition to a royal room dating back to the Muhammad Ali dynasty, a Bedouin tent that reflects the lifestyle of the Sinai inhabitants, and the Tutankhamun exhibition, which includes 12 distinctive pieces. It will continue until the opening of the Grand Egyptian Museum.

The most popular tourist activities you can do include:

Private Tour of Sharm El Sheikh Museum

Driving in a private car with air conditioning, you will be picked up from your hotel or the port to be brought to the Sharm el-Sheikh Museum, where you will get to see the impressive exhibits it has on offer. One masterpiece of the museum is called The Holy Family, and it shows Virgin Mary supporting the baby Jesus, while off to the side stands John the Baptist.

Joseph the Carpenter and Salome also step into the background, which gives endless depth to this undefined piece. According to one of the museum interpreters, this picture represents Christmas, a time of great pleasure and peace since the birth of Christ established the precedent for settling human strife. At the end of your tour, you will be returned to your hotel or to the port of Sharm El Sheikh.

Other trips that you can do in Sharm El Sheikh include: The Peace Mosque, also known as the Great Mosque of Sharm el-Sheikh and opened on December 12, 2001, is the biggest mosque in the city. Its name was later changed to "Al-Salam." The Heavenly Church is situated in the Al-Nour area of the coastal town. On Airport Road, the Sharm el-Sheikh International Museum stretches over 191,000 square meters.

The structure includes 9 halls, a conference room, a basement, some souvenir shops of folk art, an open-air theater, and several cafes. The museum, which spans 52 acres, contains about 7,000 treasures of ancient and modern times.
