Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive Cairo - Check-in

An airport agent from Cairo Top Tours will greet you at Cairo International Airport and assist you to have smooth measures and exit. You will be transported to your hotel in a comfortable, air-conditioned vehicle. Once at the hotel, your tour guide will go over your itinerary for the Cairo, Nile Cruise & Red Sea Tour and confirm all pick-up times for your Egypt Travel Packages. They will also help you with a speedy check-in process.

You can either spend your first evening at leisure or opt to book a tour for the Sound and Light Show at Giza Pyramids area.

Spend a night at a hotel in Cairo.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids & Sphinx and Sakkara tour

Cairo Top Tours agent will meet you at Cairo International Airport holding a sign with your name. They will then transport you to your hotel in a private air-conditioned vehicle. Upon arrival, they will help you check in quickly and smoothly.

On your first evening, you can have time to relax or instead of it upon request go to the Sound and Light Show at Giz. At the begging of the first day, start with breakfast at the hotel, followed by a meeting with your private Egyptologist from Cairo Top Tours. They will guide you through the tours in Giza, making it

easy for you to learn about the Great Pyramid of King Cheopsand his successors, Chephren and Mycerinus. They will also help you capture the most memorable photos of the sites, should you choose to take a camel ride at the Giza Pyramids area (optional activity). Then, you will be taken to see the famous Sphinx, which has been guarding the necropolis for over 4500 years with its iconic man-headed lion figure.

Once you have learned about the construction of the pyramids, you can proceed to the Valley Temple of King Chephren to gain further knowledge about the mummification process's great secrets in ancient Egypt. In the past, every pyramid complex consisted of a valley temple, a mortuary temple, and a burial tomb (which was the pyramid itself). Out of all the monuments on the site, the pyramid complex of King Khafre is the only one that is mostly intact. The valley temple was utilized for pre-burial rituals for the pharaoh.

The Giza Pyramids tour comprises a panoramic excursion that offers a view of all the pyramids in Giza, allowing tourists to capture unforgettable photographs for memories.

You can visit the open-air museum at the site where Memphis, the ancient capital of the pharaohs during the age of the pyramids or the new kingdom, used to be to see the alabaster sphinx statue of Ramses II.

After a delicious lunch, you will go to Saqqara, which is one of the most valuable sites of antiquities and discoveries in Egypt. At Saqqara, you will see the Step Pyramid Complex and the pyramid of king Djoser, which is the first building in the world completely made out of 6 stone bases above each other. You will also have the opportunity to go inside the Pyramid of Teti and one of the tombs of the Nobles, such as the Kagemni tomb.

Your day will be at the end by reaching your hotel.

Day 3 : Cairo sightseeing tour

After enjoying the open buffet breakfast at your hotel in Cairo, you can continue your Egypt Tours Packages with the assistance of your private tour guide. Your first stop will be The Egyptian Museum, where you can witness the largest collection of Egyptian antiquities in the world, spread across two floors of the museum. Additionally, you will get to see the magnificent royal treasures of King Tutankhamen, which were discovered intact. The Egyptian Museum is enriched with Royal mummies, massive statues, royal golden possessions, and beautifully designed accessories of the Egyptian queens.

Once you finish your tour of the Egyptian Museum, you can look forward to exploring Coptic Cairo. This includes a visit to the Hanging Church, which is constructed above the towers of the ancient Roman fortress known as Babylon, as well as the church of Abu Serga, where you can view the crypt that housed the holy family for approximately three months during a period of persecution. Your Coptic Cairo tour will also take you to the Ben Ezra Synagogue, which, according to Jewish tradition, is where the Pharaoh's daughter discovered the basket containing baby Moses in the Nile.

After enjoying your lunch at a nearby restaurant, you will be accompanied by a personal driver and guide to visit the Citadel of Saladin. Inside the Alabaster Mosque, you can witness a breathtaking view of the historic mosques, domes, and minarets that make up Islamic Cairo, making this attraction a standout among all of our Cairo excursions. The mosque, designed with Turkish architecture in mind, was constructed by Mohamed Ali back in 1805.

You will be transferred to your Islamic Cairo trips where you can explore the walls, gates, and old streets of Fatimid Cairo. Additionally, you will have a one-of-a-kind shopping experience in the Khan El Khalili Bazaar in Cairo.

You have the option to take a tour in the evening and have dinner on a Nile cruise in Cairo.

Day 04: Cairo to Aswan and Embarkation to your Nile cruise
