Day 1 : Arrival Cairo

A Cairo Top Tours representative waits near the front of Cairo International Airport to receive you with a personalized sign bearing your name. You will reach your hotel by means of a contemporary vehicle with air conditioning. Proceed to check-in at your hotel where you will receive a welcome drink followed by itinerary and tour pick-up schedule confirmation service.

Overnight in Cairo.

Day 2 : Pyramids Tour

After having your delicious breakfast at your hotel in Cairo, you will meet your tour guide to start your day.

First, you will see [the Great Pyramid of king Cheops](#) -the only remaining monument of the seven ancient wonders of the world, still standing since 2500 B.C. now. You will also visit the pyramid of [Chephren](#) - built by King Chephren from the 4th dynasty the son of King Cheops, and the pyramid of [Mycerinus](#). You will also visit the [Valley Temple](#).

Your visit to the Giza pyramids area includes a tour that takes you to see all the pyramids together and take pictures and beautiful memories.

After having lunch at a local restaurant on the way to [Saqqara](#), you will visit [the Stepped Pyramid Complex](#). It was built for the burial of king Djoser between 2717 B.C and 2737 B.C through his minister Imhotep, and it is considered the first huge stone building in history. And you will also see there the [the Pyramid of Teti](#), and the noble's tombs to see a glimpse of daily life in ancient Egypt.

Then, you will be going to [Memphis](#). Memphis was founded about 3,200 years ago by [King Narmer](#). It was the capital of Egypt during the old kingdom and it is still an important city today. You will visit an open-air museum to see many famous monuments, including two statues of [King Ramses II](#) and a statue of the alabaster Sphinx of Memphis.

Our representative will help you to understand this historical area in detail and will take beautiful photos to preserve this moment for you.

Back to your hotel and overnight in Cairo.

Day 3: Cairo Tour

This thrilling sightseeing excursion reveals all the significant sites in Cairo. Experience the Egyptian Museum which holds more than 120,000 artifacts with King Tutankhamun's royal golden treasure among them. The tour will then take you to the 12th-century Citadel of Saladin followed by the Mohamed Ali Mosque which showcases its distinctive Ottoman-style design through its white alabaster walls.

Travel to Coptic Cairo to see the oldest church in Egypt at the Hanging Church alongside the Church of St. Sergius which holy scriptures suggest was the place where the Holy Family rested. Make sure to experience the historical significance of the Ben Ezra Synagogue which is linked to the baby Moses events.

The last stop should visit Islamic Cairo to see its maze of traditional streets coupled with mosque exploration. The final stop should be Khan El Khalili Bazaar where visitors can purchase souvenirs and traditional items while enjoying the opportunity to experience the famous market of Cairo.

Day 4: Alexandria sightseeing

Start the day with hotel breakfast then welcome your Egyptologist guide who will lead your trip to Alexandria which people often call the "Pearl of the Mediterranean" and Egypt's second-largest urban center. The city of Alexandria existed since Alexander the Great established it in 332 BC and still maintains its heritage by reflecting ancient Greek Roman and Egyptian elements.

The 2-hour trip will take you towards Alexandria while you enjoy riding in a modern vehicle through beautiful landscapes from Cairo. When traveling towards Alexandria you will find a brief interruption for refreshments and rest before the destination.

Top Attractions in Alexandria

Pompey's Pillar

Travel to Alexandria to experience the single pillar which survived from Serapeum Temple during its dedication to Serapis the Greco-Egyptian deity. The 26.85-meter (88-foot) tall red granite column that people previously attributed to Pompey in reality was built to honor Emperor Diocletian in the 3rd century A.D.

Citadel of Qaitbay

Travelers can explore this 15th-century palace on the ancient ruins of the Lighthouse of Alexandria that was among the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. Sultan Al-Ashraf Qaitbay built the Citadell of Qaitbay at 15th century to defend Alexandria from Ottoman invaders. During Ottoman invasion times this ancient fortress served to guard Alexandria while presenting beautiful views across the Mediterranean Sea.

Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa

Travelers can see the biggest Roman tomb complex from the 2nd century A.D. at this location. The underground tombs use artistic designs taken from Pharaonic and Greek and Roman traditions to spread burial chambers and statues and carvings throughout their three structural levels.

Bibliotheca Alexandrina

The new Library of Alexandria serves as a modern tribute to the historic Great Library of Alexandria that used to be an ancient center for educational pursuits. Bibliotheca Alexandrina now contains millions of books and exhibits a planetarium and museum and cultural exhibits as well as being a center of learning for Alexandria's history.

St. Mark's Church

One of the oldest churches in Africa, St. Mark's Church is believed to be founded by St. Mark the Evangelist, who introduced Christianity to Egypt in the 1st century A.D.

Old Downtown & Local Markets

Stroll through Alexandria's historic city center, where you can admire baroque, Italian, and French-style architecture. Visit the traditional markets in Mansheya, including the ladies' market (Zan'et Elsetat), known for its narrow alleys filled with textiles, perfumes, and jewelry. The gold market is a popular spot for wedding and engagement jewelry shopping.

Abbo Elabbas Mosque & Funfair

Visit Alexandria's largest mosque, the Abbo Elabbas Mosque, known for its stunning Islamic architecture.

Outside, experience a vintage funfair, where children enjoy old-fashioned rides and candy floss.

The Corniche & Old Harbor

Take in the views along the Alexandria Corniche, where you'll see traditional fishing boats, local fishermen, and net makers at work. This is a perfect spot for amazing photos.

Lunch & Return to Cairo

Enjoy a delicious seafood lunch at a high-quality local restaurant, experiencing Alexandria's famous Mediterranean cuisine. After lunch, begin your drive back to Cairo, with a short break on the way.
