## Day 1: Arrive Cairo, Egypt

Upon arrival at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, you will be met and assisted by Cairo Top Tours Englishspeaking tour guide who will transfer you to your hotel in Cairo by an exclusive air-conditioned vehicle. Upon arrival at the hotel you will be served a welcome drink while he assist you with a smooth check-in and walk you through your Egypt Travel Packages details.

Overnight and get ready for your early morning tour to the Pyramids of Egypt.

## **Day 2: Pyramids and Sphinx Excursion**

After breakfast, you'll be picked up by our professional guide from the hotel lobby to begin your adventurous Cairo Day Tour to <u>The Pyramids of Giza</u> and the <u>Sphinx</u>, which is said to have resembled King Chephren, the owner of the middle pyramid.

## Day 6: Abu Simbel Temples

They are monuments to the king and his queen Nefertari, and to commemorate his victory at the

Battle of Kadesh, their huge external rock relief figures have become iconic.

### Day 7: Aswan to Luxor - Luxor Temple

After having breakfast at your hotel in Aswan you will be transferred to Luxor and you will enjoy <u>Luxor day</u> tours to the magnificent <u>Temple of Luxor</u> which was built by King Amenhotep III in the 18th Dynasty (New Kingdom) and was completed by Ramesses II during the 19th Dynasty.

### Day 8: Karnak Temple - Luxor West Bank - Transfer to Hurghada by Land

Today you will visit the biggest temple in the world, <u>Karnak Temple</u>, the greatest example of greatness in <u>the</u> <u>history of Egypt</u>. The temple is dedicated to the most important God Amun, his consort the famous Goddess Mut, and their son Khonsu. The building was constructed from the beginning of the Middle Kingdom to the Graeco-Roman era by many Egyptian kings.

Also, you will visit the monuments of the West bank of the Nile, <u>Hatshepsut Temple</u> in Deir Al-Bahary, <u>The</u> <u>Valley of kings</u>, and the Colossi of Memnon.

After that, you will be transferred to Hurghada by land for about 3 hours drive and then overnight in your Hurghada hotel.

### Day 9: Submarine Excursion in Hurghada

After breakfast, you'll enjoy an amazing two-hour trip underwater on <u>Sindbad Submarine</u>, viewing different types of marine life and colorful fish on the <u>Red Sea</u>. This submarine has a capacity of 44 passengers, and its crew of two captains will take you on a wonderful trip beneath the sea. It goes 22 meters deep below sea level. You don't need to be a scuba diver to enjoy this trip – it's accessible to everyone. When you finish, you'll be transferred back to your hotel in Hurghada.
