Day 1: Arrival in Cairo

When you reach Luxor International Airport, you will find a professional tour leader proceeding to greet you. A private air-conditioned transportation will take you to your chosen luxury hotel after your welcome at Luxor International Airport.

The representative present at the hotel assists guests with hotel check-in procedures and reviews the scheduled tours during your Egypt Classic Tours while confirming the times for upcoming activities. Spend your leisure time indoors at your hotel before getting ready for the foresting adventures. Overnight stay in Luxor.

Day 2: Pyramids Tour

You should begin your day by enjoying breakfast at the hotel and then start exploring the historic sites of Cairo with an expert guide. While experiencing the prime overlooks of Cairo from Salah El-Din Citadel, your specialist tour leader will guide your way throughout the visit. Experience the grandiosity of the Mohamed Ali Mosque, which people commonly call the Alabaster Mosque because of its beautiful Ottoman-style architectural features.

The Egyptian Museum awaits visitors with its pharaonic treasure collection that features the golden mask of Tutankhamun and ancient artefacts dated back thousands of years. Walk through the museum corridors that display Egypt's fascinating historical information.

The afternoon brings you to view the historical destinations in Old Cairo, containing the Hanging Church and the Ben Ezra Synagogue, which showcase rich cultural background. The Khan El Khalili Bazaar welcomes visitors to meander its twisting alleys where they can find traditional crafts and jewellery along with souvenir shops.

Your hotel in Cairo will serve as your accommodation for the night.

For those interested, the Nile dinner cruise with live performances can be arranged.

Day 3: Cairo Tours

A professional tour guide will lead you to the Grand Egyptian Museum in Giza after your breakfast during this day of your Cairo tour. The museum holds one of the biggest arrays of valuable ancient Egyptian artefacts available across the globe. Tourists admire two main collections of remarkable importance at the museum, which are Ramses II relics and Queen Nefertari's tomb artefacts. You can discover Egyptian historical elements along with royal mummies within the museum through its spectacular display of ancient statues and intricate jewellery.

The Giza Plateau remains your initial destination, where you can witness both the Pyramids of Giza along with the Great Sphinx. Over 4,500 years ago, ancient Egyptians created these magnificent vestiges, which showcase their remarkable structural capabilities. The Solar Boat Museum contains a nameless carpentry piece that scientists think Pharaoh Khufu permitted for his trip to the world beyond. The site finishes with spectacular sights of both the pyramids and the desert scenery.

You should now proceed to Memphis, which was established as Egypt's first unified capital around 3100 BC. Visitors can behold both the Ramses II statue and the Alabaster Sphinx at this location. People visiting the Saqqara Necropolis can marvel at the Step Pyramid of Djoser, which established itself as the world's first stone structure. Your guide will share interesting historical stories about both pharaohs and their burial traditions.

Conclude your day with a visit to Khan El Khalili, one of the oldest markets in the Middle East. Enjoy a refreshing cup of hibiscus tea at the famous El Fishawy Café, and immerse yourself in the vibrant atmosphere as you shop for unique souvenirs, spices, and handmade crafts.

An optional evening activity includes attending the Sound and Light Show at the Pyramids, where the history of ancient Egypt comes to life through a mesmerizing display of lights and narration.

Day 04: Cairo to Aswan

From your breakfast, you will get transferred to Cairo International Airport, where you will receive your domestic flight to Luxor. The arrival of your guide will then lead you through boarding procedures onto your Nile cruise.

The cruise journey will require you to sail aboard a felucca boat while visiting both the Valley of Kings and the Temple of Hatshepsut.

After your cruise ship travels, you will come back to resume your stay on the ship to experience afternoon tea from the sun deck. The Nile cruise's first night will be enhanced by a delectable supper followed by an exciting traditional Egyptian show.

Day 5: Aswan Tours/ Kom Ombo

The Nile River provides a peaceful sight while you have your first meal of the day. Schedule time to see the historical landmarks at Aswan High Dam followed by Unfinished Obelisk in the Aswan quarries and afterwards move on to the Temple of Philae. After your sightseeing conclude you can embark your Nile cruise at Kom Ombo destination. As your boat stops for the day you will indulge in an excellent buffet dining experience. The following stop will be the Temple of Kom Ombo where your guide will introduce you to Sobek and Horus worship. Take a peaceful afternoon tea on Sun Deck to appreciate the beautiful landscapes. The evening brings a pleasant dining experience aboard the cruise vessel as it continues its navigation. A day journey to Abu Simbel temple is possible with advance request.

Day 6: Edfu Temple

After breakfast, head to **Kom Ombo** to explore the **Temple of Kom Ombo**, dedicated to both the crocodile god **Sobek** and the falcon god **Horus**. This unique double temple is renowned for its symmetrical design and beautiful reliefs.

Next, sail towards **Aswan**, enjoying lunch on board and afternoon tea. In the evening, unwind with a delightful **dinner** on the **Nile Cruise**, followed by an entertaining **Egyptian music and dance show**.

Day 7: Luxor West Bank

Later, return to your Nile Cruise, where you'll enjoy a delicious dinner and a Nubian folklore show to end your evening.
