[the Nubian museum:](#)

Next to the Fatimid domes on a high hill is the Nubian Museum in Aswan. The Nubian antiquities merge with the Egyptian antiquities and some of the different eras that passed through Aswan. The museum is a window to the world on a long history that some researchers see as complicated.

[the Kalabsha temple:](#)

Kalabsha Temple is one of the most beautiful and complete existing temples in Lower Nubia. It was built during the reign of Augustus (30 BC – 14 AD), the first Roman emperor; This temple was mainly dedicated to the Nubian deity Mandulis, as well as ancient Egyptian deities such as Isis and her husband Osiris.
