The pyramid of Teti at Saqqara, the founder of the Sixth Dynasty who ruled Egypt after Pharaoh Unas, followed the example of Unas: the central masonry was made of tightly packed blocks of stone, enclosed in fine limestone. and a lot of kings.

Day Trip to Saqqara Necropolis

Your Private tour guide will meet you at the hotel lobby to start one of the most amazing Tours from Cairo, The Day Trip to Saqqara Necropolis, which is about 30 kilometers north of the capital where the first-ever known pyramid in history persists, <u>Djoser Step Pyramid</u>, the pyramid that signifies the development of the mastaba tombs till it gets to be the perfect-shaped pyramid that we know nowadays, whose secrets still need to be discovered, did not get popular because it was the first large stone pyramid in ancient Egypt, but because it constructs primitive materials such as clay bricks only., you can go inside one of the pyramids in Saqqara which don't require the booking of an extra ticket, like the <u>Pyramid of King Teti</u> or the Pyramid of <u>Unas</u>, the last King of the <u>fifth dynasty</u> also is open to visitors where you can visit one of the <u>Tombs of the Nobles at Saqqara</u>, like the tomb of Kagemni.

You will see the different carvings of all kinds of daily life scenes in ancient Egypt with all its activities clearly seen, like harvesting, fishing, hunting, and animal sacrificing scenes, painted in bright colors on the walls and burial chambers of those rock-cut tombs that some of them still retain the original colors.

Continue <u>Cairo sightseeing tours</u> to explore the Museum of <u>Imhotep</u>. The museum is one of several halls with more than 500 rare artifacts extracted from the <u>Saqqara</u> archaeological site. The exhibition includes a model of the Zoser funerary collection, and one of the museum's halls is created in the form of a complete cemetery featuring a mummy, a wooden coffin, and several pottery and pasteurized pots.

You can ask your private Egyptologist to take you to government-authorized bazaars to learn about ancient Egyptian handicrafts and to buy souvenirs that will remind you of your lovely tours to Egypt.
