Grand Egyptian Museum Tour in Giza

Cairo Top Tours' expert tour guide will pick you up from your hotel for your Grand Egyptian Museum Tour, which will begin with a visit to the Great [Necropolis of Giza](#). Today, we will make your dream come true by visiting the Great Pyramid of King Cheops, which was built as a burial tomb for the Egyptian pharaoh [Cheops](#)' son, King [Snefru](#). It took nearly 20 years to be built and has three burial chambers inside.

The great pyramid is the only monument remaining from the seven man-made wonders of the ancient world the pyramid of [Chephren](#) who succeeded his father and built his pyramid slightly smaller than his father's tomb, and the last or the smallest among them is the pyramid of king [Mycerinus](#) which still have evidence of the outer casing layer that used to cover the three pyramids from outside.

You will also visit the Great [Sphinx](#) of [King Khafre](#) which was carved with a figure of a man-headed lion to symbolize the strength and cleverness of the ancient Egyptian pharaoh before continuing your Giza Pyramids Tour to visit [the Valley Temple](#) or the [mummification](#) temple of king Chephren. Then have your lunch at a local restaurant to enjoy the [Egyptian cuisine](#) and move to visit the Grand [Egyptian Museum](#) or the one billion dollars museum because it cost that much to build it, which features artifacts from all the different periods of the [Pharaonic period](#),
