Sakkara:

Saqqara is a very important part of the Memphis necropolis, about 40 km from Cairo. Saqqara probably took its name from the cemetery's "sugar" deity. Saqqara is truly an open museum, as Saqqara includes most of the monuments of ancient Egyptian history, as it contains the tombs of kings and senior officials of the first and second families (about 3040-2686 BC).

Memphis:

The name "Memphis" ?????? is a Greek name, a distortion of the name of the pyramid of Pepi II of Nefer. Elly was exiled to Coptic. Narmer founded the first ruling family, made a solid army to protect the country, and made Memphis the capital of Egypt.

Egyptian museum:

Among the museum's unparalleled collections are the funerary collection of Yuya and Tuya, Psusennes I and the treasures of Tanis, and the Narmer Palette commemorating the unification of Upper and Lower Egypt under a single king are among the priceless artifacts in the museum.
