The citadel is immense with gigantic towers and composed of various buildings inside like [the Mosque of Al Nasir Mohamed](#) and the Military Museum, but among the most impressive of them all is the [Alabaster Mosque](#) of Mohamed Ali Basha, this Albanian origin founder of Modern Egypt who was brought by a Royal Decree from the head of the Ottoman Empire in Turkey to stand against the French Napoleonic Expedition in Egypt, he then remained after he realized the significance of Egypt's location, atmosphere, and manpower that this country could rule the whole world again as before during the new kingdom of the ancient [Egypt history](#) when Egypt reached Mesopotamia and Lybia.
