It also contains a number of pyramids, including the Step Pyramid of Djoser, which dates back to the era of the Third Dynasty, which is the oldest known complete stone structure, in addition to a number of archaeological mastabas

## Giza Pyramids and Saqqara tour from AirPort including Motor Boat Ride

Your private tour guide will pick you up from the <u>Cairo airport</u> in a luxurious air-conditioned car or van in the morning and transport you to the World of the Pharaohs where you may explore the exhibits and learn about their lives.

on the first site, We will take you to see the most famous of all Egyptian pyramids, Giza pyramids regarded as one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World, are a sight to behold. You can explore the complex and marvel at the engineering ingenuity that went into their construction.

the Great Pyramid of King Khufu Cheops, as well as the second pyramid of the 4th pharaoh of the 4th dynasty, King Khafra Chephren, and the last pyramid built in the Giza Necropolis for King Menkaure Mycerinus. Also, you will get entrance tickets to The King Chephren Pyramid, also known as the Pyramid of Khafre, it is the second-largest pyramid in Giza and is believed to have been built as a tomb for the Pharaoh Khafre, who ruled Egypt during the 4th Dynasty.

Saqqara, on the other hand, is home to the famous Step Pyramid of Djoser which is believed to be the first pyramid ever built, the Tombs of Nobles, and the Seapeum.

The Serapeum is a series of underground tunnels and chambers, and you have an entrance ticket to this place, inside the Serapeum, there are long tunnels, each of which leads to a large chamber that contains a sarcophagus made of granite or basalt. These sarcophagi were used to hold the mummified remains of the Apis bulls, which were considered sacred in ancient Egyptian religion. The tunnels were also decorated with paintings and inscriptions that depict the rituals and ceremonies associated with the Apis bulls.

Now we will take the vehicle to Cairo downtown to enjoy a relaxing Nile felucca ride on the Nile in Cairo for half an hour to view the fascinating sunset aboard a sailing boat on the eternal Nile River which is the main reason behind this great civilization that enabled ancient Egyptians to build enormous structures to serve as burial tombs in a time when other civilizations were starving and trying to settle to enjoy prosperity.

End your day with a dinner at a local restaurant that serves delicious Egyptian cuisine.
