Begin your trip from your hotel in [Dahab](#) as you will be transferred by a private air-conditioned vehicle guided by your professional English-speaking driver to Taba where you will take the ferry boat to Aqaba in [Jordan](#) and then to Petra, the famous red-rose city to see one of the best cities in history, Petra is considered one of the new seven wonders of the world, as it contains ancient architecture, dates back to the sixth century B.C and this magnificence appears clearly in the (aged and well-preserved at the same time) rock-carved buildings. after you arrive you will walk 700 meters to the Siq which is a natural gorge through the Treasury, the Royal Tombs, and the remarkable portrait of the whole area that reflects the enchantress of Mother Nature mixed with the brilliance of Humanity.
