Additionally, you will have entrance tickets to the Pyramid of King Chepran in the Giza Pyramids and the Serapeum in Saqqara.

And lastly, taking a boat ride on the Nile is a great opportunity to discover the river and its environs. With a length of over 4,000 miles from its source in East Africa to the Mediterranean Sea, the Nile is the longest river in the world.

Cairo top tours professional tour guide will meet you at your hotel lobby in Dahab to accompany you to [Sharm El Sheikh airport](#) to catch your flight heading towards Cairo where you will enjoy Dahab to Cairo trips, upon arrival at Cairo international airport, you will be welcomed by our representative who will be holding a signboard having your name to assist you at the airport and introduce you to your tour guide who will accompany you through your Giza Pyramids tour.

in Giza Necropolis, Discover the tallest building in the world, the Great Pyramids of [King Khufu Cheops](#), son of King [Snefru](#) who was the founder of the [fourth dynasty](#) of ancient Egyptian history. The pyramid was the highest building in the world until the 14th century.

Our Egyptologist guide will take you to reach [King Khafra Chephren](#), and the last pyramid built in the Giza Necropolis for King Menkaure Mycerinus. Also, you will get entrance tickets to The King Chephren Pyramid, also known as the Pyramid of Khafre, it is the second-largest pyramid in Giza and is believed to have been built as a tomb for the Pharaoh Khafre, who ruled Egypt during the 4th Dynasty.

Continue your Cairo Tours to [Saqqara](#) by visiting the first tomb that builds in the shape of a Pyramid by the ancient Egyptians, [the Step Pyramid](#) was designed by the intellectual architect Imhotep and created during Egypt's third dynasty for King [Djoser](#) who was the first King who had a step pyramid for him. then, You will visit one of the Mastaba [Tombs of the Nobles at Saqqara](#) to see the daily life scenes in ancient Egypt with all its activities and even the various corridors of the tombs.

After that, you will get an entrance ticket to the Serapeum, it's an underground complex located in the Saqqara necropolis near Memphis. It is a popular tourist attraction, offering visitors a glimpse into the mysteries of ancient Egyptian religion and the impressive engineering skills of the time.

At the end, we will take the vehicle to Cairo downtown to enjoy a relaxing [Nile felucca ride on the Nile in Cairo](#) for half an hour to view the fascinating sunset aboard a sailing boat on the eternal Nile River.
