You will be able to see the incredible obelisks.

The last part of this exotic show will be done while you are sitting by the sacred lake, it takes about 1 hour and 15 minutes for the whole spectacular Sound and Light Show in Karnak Temple, one of the most exciting things to do in Luxor.
