Itinerary

The tour guide will pick you up from the hotel to an air conditional vehicle.

First, you will see The location of the <u>Luxor temple</u> on –Southern side - to the ancient Egyptians, it was named like that because it lay beside ancient Thebes. There are also about 3 kilometers to the south of Karnak Temple, where it was once connected with a processional way bordered by sphinxes. It was built in the eighteenth dynasty so that is strong proof that it is the oldest building there.

Then you will move to <u>The Valley of the Kings</u> is the place of burial tombs for many of the ancient Egyptian kings especially the rich nobles of the great kingdoms (the 18th, 19th, and 12th Dynasties).

The third stage you will visit is the Ramesseum temple which is found on the West Bank of Luxor. It is in early age was built as the mortuary temple of Ramses II. He was about 67 years rule and experienced the creation of many remarkable public buildings and architectural wonders.

we will continue to reach the Colossi of Memnon the two huge statues of Amenhotep III were named after the ancient hero from Grace called Memnon who was an Ethiopian king and eventually he died in a battle with Achilles

And finally, we will visit Howard Carter's house the British archaeologist, who added one of the valuest contributions to Egyptology. He discovered the large tomb of King Tutankhamun in 1922 in one piece. On November 4, 1922, Carter found the first sign of what proved to be Tutankhamun's tomb, but it was not until November 26 that a second sealed doorway was reached, behind which was the treasure.
