Monastery of the Saints, Mount Todd, Luxor.

The monastery of the saints of the two martyrs, Anba Beshay and Anba Bassantous, is located east of the village of Todd Armant, in the middle of the village cemetery. The complex of the monastery churches building consists of the old church and has four structures in one row and two khors. The newer church consists of 12 domes, three structures, and nine naves, dating back to the 18th and 19th centuries. The two churches are built of mud bricks and are located to the west of the church. old bathtub box.

Deir El-Shayeb in Luxor

The monastery of Anba Pachomius Al-Shayeb has located approximately 6 km from Luxor (the ancient city of Thebes) on the eastern mainland and 671 km from Cairo. The ancient church is the only remaining ancient building, and it dates back to the fourteenth century AD and was restored in the seventeenth century AD.
