This temple has been well preserved even though it has suffered some damage due to earthquakes over time.

You'll have some time to relax and enjoy yourself before setting off again on your journey through the Luxor West Bank tour showing you some of the most famous sites, including the Valley of the Kings and Queens where many rulers from ancient Egypt were buried there, so you can see more than 60 tombs belonging to ancient Egyptian rulers.
