You will begin your walk to the holy site where the Prophet Moses received the Ten Commandments from God when you arrive at Mount Sinai.

Climb to a height of 2285 meters, then ascend 750 steps to the mountain's summit while strolling through the night.available to make a Camel ride payment

Depending on the group's performance, you could get to the peak sooner than you planned. You'll get a chance to unwind completely as you watch the sun's magnificence gently disperse across the mountains. Take some amazing pictures and, if you want to, say a prayer while admiring the dawn, then start the ascent back down.
